SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2017

1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Organising Authority (OA) is Ballyholme Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Optimist Dinghy Association of Ireland (IODAI)

2 OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

- 2.1 The Official Notice Board is located on the south window of the race office – readable from the outside.

3 LOCATION OF SIGNAL FLAGPOLE

- 3.1 The Signal flag pole is the main flagpole on the sea side of the clubhouse.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration, Measurement and Racing

5 RACING AREA

- 5.1 The Racing area will be immediately to the north of Ballyholme Bay.

6 MARKS

- 6.1 Marks 1, 2, 3P and 3S will be Yellow inflatables. The start mark will be a Green Inflatable and the finish Mark will be a Red Inflatable.

7 AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 There are no areas that are obstructions.

8 START LINE

- 8.1 The starting line will be between an orange mast displaying an orange flag on the committee vessel at the starboard end and the windward side of a green inflatable buoy.

9 FINISH LINE

- 9.1 The finishing line will be between a mast displaying a blue flag on a committee vessel and the course side of a Red Inflatable buoy.

10 PROTEST ROOM

- 10.1 The Protest room is located in the dark blue Portacabin in the north dinghy park

11 SCORING

- 11.1 8 Races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 When fewer than six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 When from six to nine races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4 When ten or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 TALLY BOARD

- 12.1 The Tally Board will be located in the gazebo on the front lawn of the Club.

13 OFFICIAL BOATS

- 14.1 The official boats will be as described on the Official Notice Board
